All Students:

- Tote Bag – exclusively used for HIH/Homeschooling work.
- Backpack free of commercial characters: used for personal items such as shoes, winter outdoor clothing, extra socks, underwear if needed, boots, lunch, etc. Brought home each day.
- Lunch box – free of commercial characters
- Water bottle labeled with student's first and last name
- One 4x6 family photo to display in classroom
- One durable, plastic folder with 2 pockets and 3 prongs, no commercial characters (to use as a weekly take home folder). It should have two pockets and be 3-hole punched.
- Primary Composition notebook – wide-line with place for pictures
- Personal Bible (any version, to be left at school)
- Story of the World chapter book by Susan Wise Bauer for history. Orange cover for 1st and 2nd grade; blue cover for 2nd and 3rd grade
- One package of Ticonderoga number 2 lead writing pencils
- 1 package of 12 Prang Colored pencils (primary colors)
- 1 box of Crayola washable markers
- 3 glue sticks
- 1 pink eraser
- 1 box Kleenex
- 1 package of coffee beans

New Students:

- 9 x 12 spiral-bound sketchbooks for science and Atrium work, durable enough to last through at least 3rd grade.
- 8 x 12 spiral-bound quadrille (graph) notebook for geometry, durable enough to last through at least 3rd grade.
- Writing notebook or binder for Story of the World History lessons.
